Shaping the Future of Latton Parish

The activities and discussions to collect information from local business, local authorities, landowners, neighbourhood parishes is almost at an end now and all the information collected has now been explored by local Parish Councillors at a meeting facilitated by Belinda Fowler at Community First. This was a lively meeting where the chance to look at what residents said in particular and what can be done about the issues raised was welcomed and ideas taken forward.

The big issues emerge as Traffic and Road Noise, Community Hub, Support for local business, Access to the Countryside, Public Transport.

Traffic Noise and the A 419 Noise Action Group (NAG) Campaign

You may have caught some high profile media attention to the A 419 NAG recently. Both BBC Wiltshire and BBC Radio 2 picked up the story from the launch event at which over 40 residents walked to Cerney Wick bridge and called for the road to be resurfaced. The Radio 2 programme highlighting many problems caused by roads was hosted by Vanessa Feltz and Paul Hodginson Chair of the A 419 NAG was interviewed. The Campaign is growing in momentum with evidence of the disruption to lives sent to the Highways Agency, but as yet no reply. 

